- 1) A Palestinian officer on the barriers of the bricand the crossing points
- 2) Gaza Jericho residents will not go through the Israeli window in the terminals. Igraelis Ean check thei: identity in an invisible way.
- 3) For the Jericho Area, the following should be ad a. The Nebi Musa (not religious affairs only)
- b. Al-Maghtas (not only prigrimage)
- c. The Lido on the Dead Sea
- d. Passages to connect the terminals to the Jericho Area
- 4) The Temporary International Presence as stated in the Oslo agreements.
